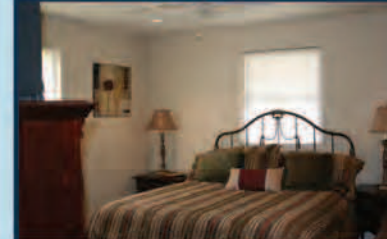

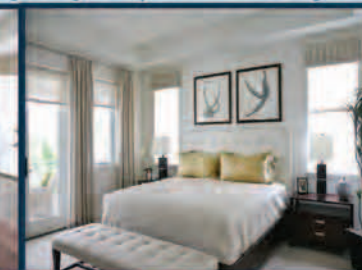
When BCB Homes went to the home for the first time to see what the project entailed, they saw rotted wood, termite damage, a clothes dryer in the kitchen that vented into the open air, leaky jalousie windows and no central air or insulation. "We knew we had a lot of work to do," says BCB Homes Project Manager, Rich Ionelli, "but we had amazing support from many subcontractors that we work with as well as from our own carpenters, office staff and their families.

The BCB Homes team included: Rich Ionelli, Chris Shaffer, Barbie Rogers, Denise Wong as well as over thirty other employees who volunteered their skills and time to renovate the home. New cabinets, bathroom fixtures, a proper laundry room, new impact glass windows, fresh paint inside and out, a concrete driveway, and landscaping with an irrigation system were some of the items companies donated to the Beal's. In addition, spray foam insulation was applied to the roof system and a central air conditioning system was installed.

Maintenance Defects – improper maintenance, methods and materials

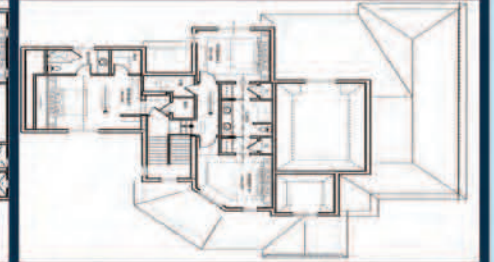
Resultant Failures – water intrusion and mold investigation
