The Avellino Model in Mediterra is well under construction and taking shape! As you can tell from the pictures above, the shell of the home and the pool is complete and the interior is underway. The 5,300 under A/C square foot home will have 4 Bedrooms, 4 I/2 Bathrooms, and an oversized Study in addition to its open and bright Great Room. The home's exterior is a Florida Transitional Architecture and will have very clean, almost contemporary style finishes both inside and out. For example, some of the tiles and cabinets selected will be sleek with clean lines. Other features inside the home are top-of-the-line appliances by Sub Zero and Wolf, a large pantry hidden with cabinetry and a very large breakfast area able to seat 8 people.

The expansive Outdoor Living Area is one of the largest we have ever built in Mediterra and has all that one would desire. The covered lanai has a bar area with a grill and sink, plus two other seating areas and roll-down screens. Then heading out to the pool, there is a sun shelf, a spa, fire urns and lots of water features. The pool not only is accommodating for cooling off, but also has a lap lane for those who like to exercise in their pool.

Q: What is the average price per square foot price of a new home today?
